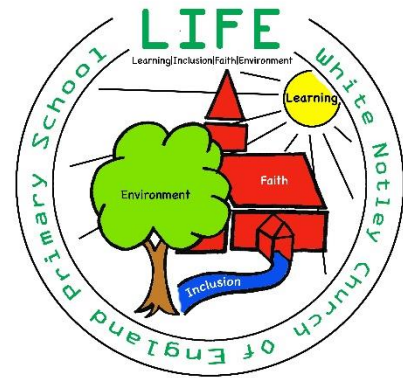

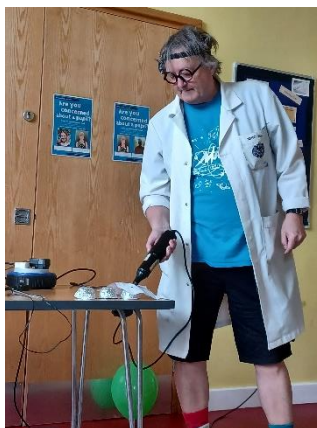

Congratulations to Oliver, who played in his first football tournament.

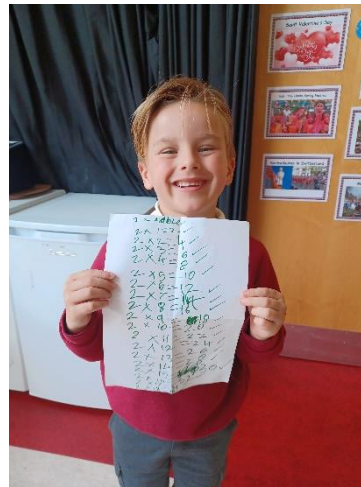
Congratulations to Flynn, who has learned to do bubble writing.
