

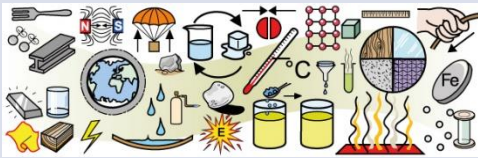
Class 3, Year 3 & 4, AUTUMN Term 2023

Science – Sound

A fun and exciting topic to begin the year with!



We will be; identifying how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating, learning that vibrations from a sound travel through a medium to the ear, looking at patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it, and the relationship between volume and vibrations.



MATHS

We follow White Rose Maths throughout school, and will be starting the year with Place Value – what is a number, the value of ones, tens, hundreds and thousands.

Moving on to addition and subtraction of 2 and 3-digit numbers, and mental and written methods. Problem solving. We will start with learning the 3 and 4 times tables in year 3, building on from counting in 2s, 5s and 10s in KS1. Year 4 will move to the 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables.

The expectation is that children know all times tables to x12 by end of year 4. Please help and support them with this. Thank you!

PSHE, Health & Wellbeing

Understanding Zones of Regulation and how to be calm and comfortable with ourselves and our surroundings. This is taught throughout the school. We will also develop how to show respect and compassion for others, with understanding of families and differences across the world.

We are excited for our learning together and the journey we are about to begin.

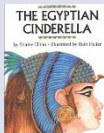
PE

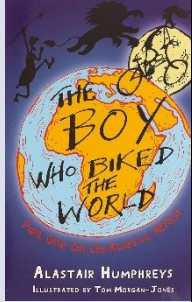

Reading

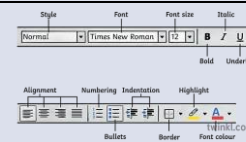
